Dear Siân Gwenllian AS,

Thank you for your contribution to the debate on the Welsh Language Commissioner's Annual Report 2023-24 on 12 November. During that debate, I promised I would write to you outlining the work that is taking place in terms of Welsh language standards.

As I mentioned during the debate, we have recently consulted on adding more bodies to existing Welsh language standards regulations. That consultation has now closed, and responses received have been analysed. We are confident that we will be able to lay the statutory instruments before the Senedd in early 2025. Those statutory instruments will add six specific bodies, and the Special Health Authorities category, to existing standards regulations, and add some of those bodies to Schedule 6 of the Welsh Language (Wales) Measure 2011. As this was a commitment that was in the Co-operation Agreement, I have asked officials to hold a briefing with Plaid Cymru's spokesperson on the Welsh language in January, to provide a more detailed update on this work.

We continue to work through the standards programme agreed in the Co-operation Agreement. Regulations making standards for healthcare regulators, and water companies have already been approved by the Senedd earlier this Senedd term.

Policy work has already started to make standards for housing associations, and I'll be happy to update you when there are more details to share. Subsequently, we will move on with preparing regulations for public transport providers.
