Dear Andrew,

I am writing further to your comments during the Business Statement in the Senedd yesterday (Wednesday 8 July).

In a question to the Trefnydd about my decision to write-off historical cash support provided to NHS organisations since 2014, you stated: *“I am amazed, unless it has come in the last hour, that we, as Members, haven’t had a statement on this – it was announced in the press conference yesterday. That surely cannot be right.*

“... So, could I implore you to seek that statement? I shouldn’t have to implore you, but could I ask you to make that statement available to Members so we can understand exactly the implications for it?”

A Written Statement about the NHS Accounts 2019-20, which included information about this decision, was published to all Members of the Senedd and on the Welsh Government’s website on Monday 6 July.
